## Toack and Recals Cucuts

- Traek and field is a sport which combines varions atheotic contegts based on the sfilels of veanning, inmping, and throwing. The name is devived from the sport's typical venne: a stadium with an oval nunning track enclosing a grass field where the throwing and jumping events tafe place.
- The rumning ovents, which include sprints, middle and long-distance events, and Arardling, ave won by the athlete with the fastest time. Most track and fleed events are individual sports with a single victor. Some f the races on the track are for teams of four runners. Gach athlete carries a small stick called baton. To win the relay race, the team's runners must be very fast, Gut they must also cooperate very well with each other.
- The iumping and throwing events are won by the athlete who achieves the greategt distance or height. Regular jumping events include cong inmp, triple inmp, Aigh iump and poce vanlt, whice the most common throwing events are shot put, iavelin, discens and hammer.
- In the discus the athlete stands inside a throwing circle, turns around one and a half times and throws the discus as far as he or she can. A discus is a round plate made of wood and metal.
In the hammer throw the athlete stands inside a throwing circle, swings the hammer and at the same time sping his or her body Gefore throwing the hammer as far as he or she can. The hammer is a metal bace on a stecl wire with a handle. In the javelin, atheetes sprint down a runway holding a javelin then throw the javelin from over their shonlder. At the end of the runway there is a eine and the judge measures the distance from this line to where the javelin lands. In shot put the atheete stands inside a circee, holding the shot and resting it against his or her shonlder. Then the athlete hops, cronches and then iumps up and pushes the shot into the air.The judge measures the distance from the circle to where the shot lands. A shot is a metal ball. Originally it was a cannon bale.
- Fonl throws occur when an athlete during the throwing motion:
- throws the equipment which either fales outside the throwing sector or tonches a sector eine on the initial impact.
- tonches with any part of the body (incending shoes):
the top or ends of the toe/stop board
the top of the iron ring
anywhere ontside the circle.
